The Assistance House (TAH) is a non-profit, a 501C (3) organization that supports helping our neighbors in need. Having its roots in an organization Col. Enderlin started in 1917, to help a fellow co-worker with work boots, we continue to assist those who are currently working and are facing financial hardship.

We help eligible families with:

- Rent Assistance up to \$300.00. Client pays the remainder.
- Utility Assistance up to \$150.00. Client pays the remainder.
- Back to work boots, non-slip shoes and work clothes as required.
- Gas cards (2- \$20.00) for those just starting a new job.
- Through partnerships we help with diapers, school shoes for children and scrubs for those working in the medical field.

To be eligible:

- Person must live in Ross County
- Client must live at a poverty level of 225% or lower
- Provide paystubs from one person living in the home, showing 4 weeks of employment.
- For Return to Work assistance must show proof of having been hired.

Our mission to support our *working neighbors* operates through private grants* and donations from local businesses and concerned citizens. The majority of the financial support we offer through vouchers remains in the community via landlords, local utilities and businesses.
